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## *Preparing to share information electronically*

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- Integrating child health information systems
  - An information system capable of producing a consolidated record of an individual that has received services from a public health agency
- Bi-directional exchange of information
- Information available at the “point of service”
- Purpose: *to share information with end users*




## *Level of Reported Integration (N=39)*
