Improve distribution of the health workforce




QUALITY

Drivers for Success



Challenges in Addressing Community Needs



- Analyzing HPSAs to ensure they measure community and health workforce needs
- Identifying workforce expansion opportunities across all programs
- Securing adequate funding to meet needs within key priority areas
- Establish training sites at a variety of institutions
- Holistically funding organizations to meet community needs
- Enhancing the infrastructure within communitybased organizations to effectively train future workforce





Strategies to Address Community Needs



- Develop or support better tools and metrics for assessing community health workforce needs
- Further expand community-based training
- Expand support for community-based infrastructure (e.g., Readiness to Train Assessment Tool)
- Facilitate new or deeper partnerships between academic institutions and community-based training sites
- Leverage the community health worker program and other HRSA community-based partners to expand the pipeline of HRSA-supported community members entering the health professions


