- ACHDNC should consider the full range of peer-reviewed evidence
- Benefits and harms to the individual child remain paramount
- Committee should also consider benefits and harms to the family and to society at large (including equity).
 - Financial/geographical considerations for the family
 - Psychological benefits/harms to the family
 - Opportunity costs to the public health system
- Harms and benefits should be supported by peer-reviewed evidence directly relevant to the condition under review.
