Missouri's Pregnancy –Related Mortality Review 2018-2020 report

Report highlights:


- Mental health conditions were the leading underlying cause of pregnancy-related deaths, followed by cardiovascular disease and homicides.
- All pregnancy-related deaths related to mental health conditions were determined to be preventable.
- Pregnancy-related deaths for Black women are more than 3 times the ratio for white women.
- Missouri has the 7th highest maternal mortality rate in the United States.
- Women on Medicaid are ten times more likely to die within 1 year of pregnancy than those with private insurance.
 - Over 64% of our pregnancies are covered by Medicaid
- Pregnancy-related mortality ratio in Missouri was 32 deaths per 100,000 live births
 - 84% of these deaths were determined to be preventable

RMOMS-Bootheel Perinatal Network:

- Nurse-Driven Clinical-Community Integrated Care Coordination model helps to identify and close gaps in care services, including Social Drivers of Health, for pregnant and parenting people while linking them to local "blessings"
- Ultrasound and telehealth services
- BoRN (Bootheel Resource Network)-Unite Us collaborative effort of a closed loop electronic resource and referral platform
- SDOH, Z-Codes, and Payment models

You Matter! Your Voice Matters!

Gives mothers the opportunity to share their unique stories of success, challenges, and gaps in pregnancy care and beyond while giving them a voice in improving maternal care

Build rapport with clients and ensure that clients feel comfortable and secure no matter the situation.

Care Coordinators use their nursing skillset to identify mental and physical risk factors, listen to clients' stories, identifies social service needs, and connects them to existing community resources, creating a bridge between clinical care and community health

Time spent with mothers is uniquely tailored to their needs and guided by evidence-based assessment tools.



MFM Clinic No Show Rates


Yearly Average No Show Rates



- BPN participants had **0** no shows in **7** of the past **12** months.
- BPN participants had 0 no shows in 15 of the 34 months since offering Care Coordination.
- 55% Reduction in BPN Participants with start of Care Coordination

• **50%** Reduction in yearly average No Show Rates overall for Bootheel Families

BPN vs Non-BPN participant No Show Rates



Rural Southeast Missouri:

- 70.4% of birthing moms received prenatal care in the first trimester compared to the state average of 71.2% now 75.27%
- 13.8% of birthing moms delivered prematurely compared to the state average of 12.6% now 12.63%
- 9.7% of infants born are considered low birth weight compared to the state average of 8.8%
- Appropriate maternal care can be 2+ hours away
- Over 60% of pregnancies are covered by Medicaid.
- Reduced employment opportunities


