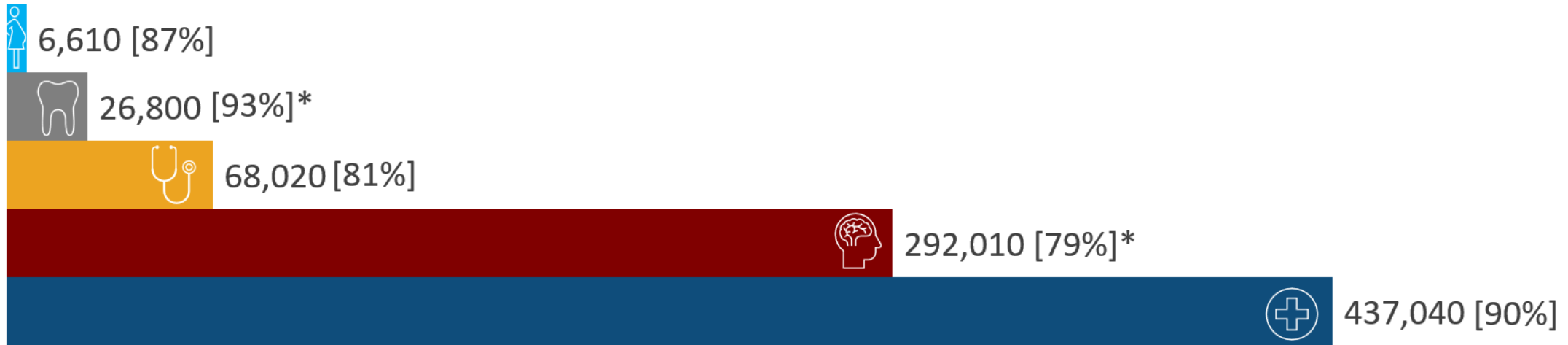

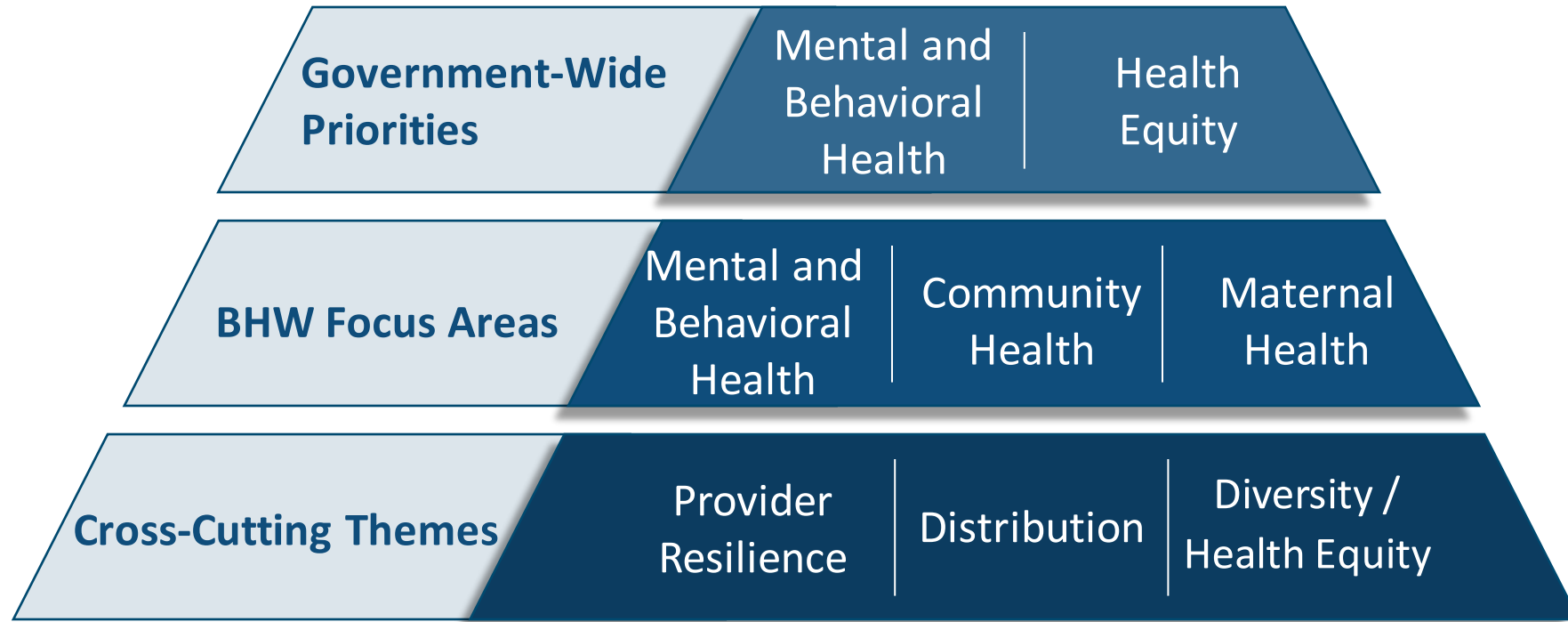

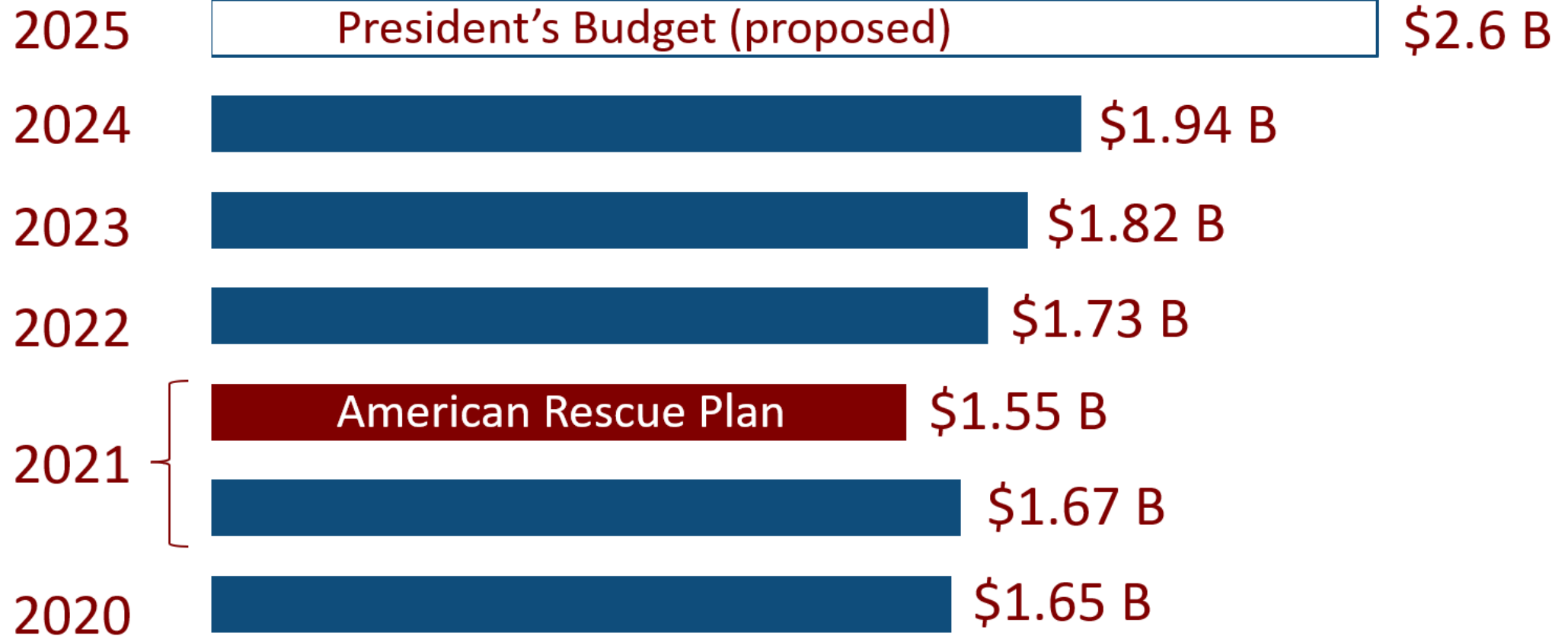

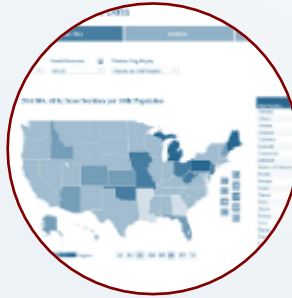

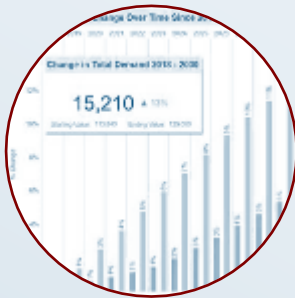


Field Strength Dashboards

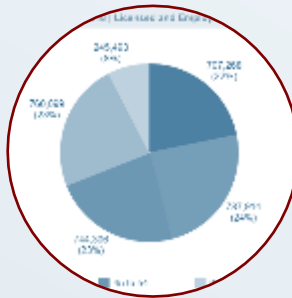

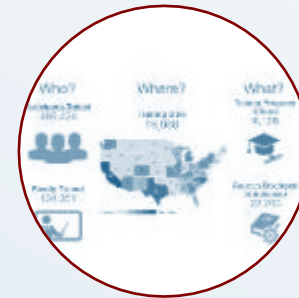

Nursing Workforce Dashboard



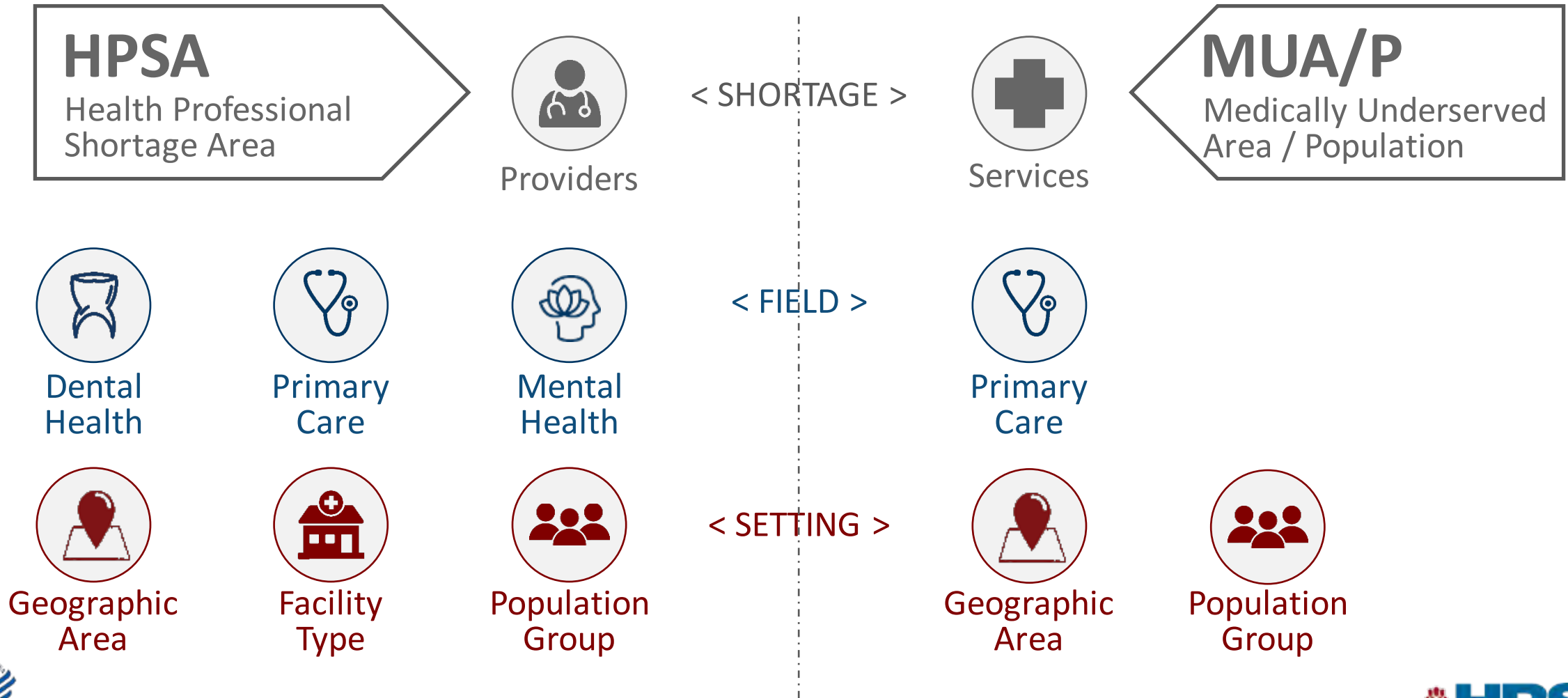
Health Professions Training Programs
