

Adopting 2 CFR 200 – Tentative

- Already adopted:
 - Statutory provisions:
 - ✓ 2 CFR Part 183 – Never Contract with the Enemy
 - ✓ 2 CFR 200.216 – Prohibition on certain telecommunications and video surveillance services or equipment
 - ✓ Revising Parts 25 and 200 for changes to FAPIIS (now R/Q)
 - Regulation changes to reduce recipient burden
 - ✓ Closeouts 2 CFR 200.344: 90 days (subrecipients); 120 days (recipients); 1 year (HRSA)



Legislative Mandates in Grants Management for FY 2024

The Further Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2024 (Public Law 118-47) signed into law on March 23, 2024:

- Provides funding to HRSA for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2024.
- Includes statutory provisions that limit the use of funds on HRSA grants and cooperative agreements for FY 2024.

Salary Rate Limitation

- HRSA adjusts recipients' budgets where requests for direct salaries are over the applicable rate. See Notice of Awards (NOA).

Responsibility/Qualification (formerly FAPIIS.gov records)

- FAPIIS integrated with Sam.gov on December 12, 2022
 - ✓ Now Responsibility/Qualification (R/Q)
- Includes:
 - ✓ Exclusions (suspension/debarment),
 - ✓ Proceedings,
 - ✓ Terminations,
 - ✓ Other responsibility and integrity information
- HRSA will review before making award over \$250k; recipient must review before making subaward or awarding contract over \$250k

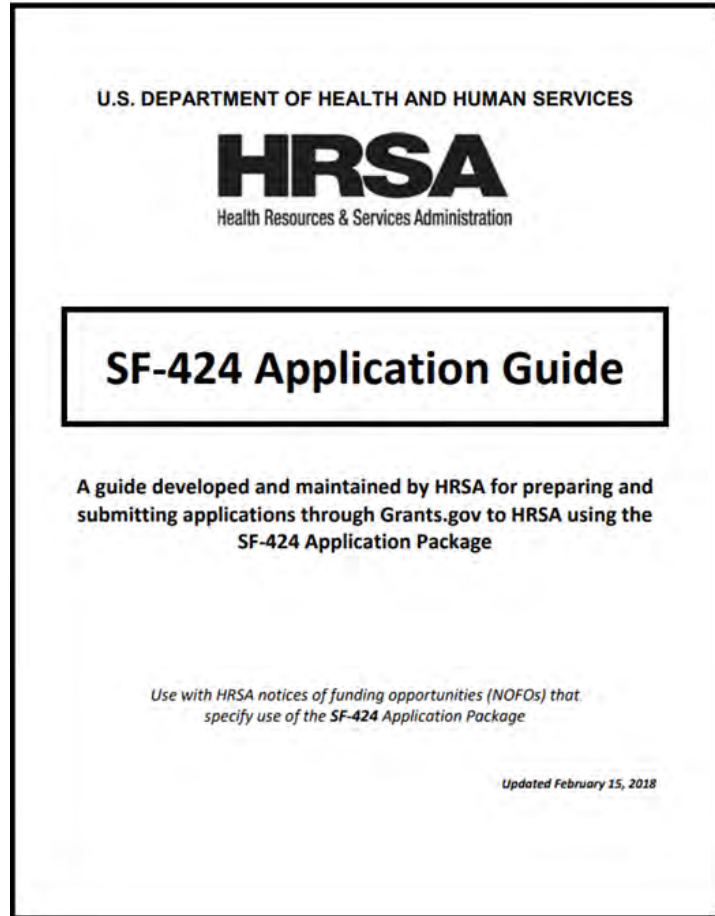
