

HRSA SUPPORTS MATERNAL HEALTH IN RURAL COMMUNITIES

HRSA's Federal Office of Rural Health Policy invested **over \$14 million** in fiscal year 2024 to **support pregnant people, as well as new moms and their babies**, in underserved rural communities. This included:



Rural Maternity and Obstetrics Management Strategies (Rural MOMS)

- **\$12 million through the Rural MOMS Program** to support rural moms through expanded maternal health services, telehealth, and funding to hire more health professionals and care coordinators.

Delta Region Maternal Care Coordination (Delta MCC) Program

- **\$2.2 million through the Delta MCC Program** to expand and improve health care services before, during, and after pregnancy for mothers who live in the Delta Region.
- Delta MCC awardees will collectively serve women to improve and increase access to care for pregnant people and new mothers during and after pregnancy in **38 rural counties across three Delta Region states—Alabama, Mississippi, and Tennessee.**
