



HRSA SUPPORTS MATERNAL HEALTH IN RURAL COMMUNITIES

HRSA's Federal Office of Rural Health Policy invested **over \$14 million** in fiscal year 2024 to **support pregnant people, as well as new moms and their babies**, in underserved rural communities. This included:

- **\$12 million through the Rural Maternity and Obstetrics Management Strategies (Rural MOMS) Program** to support rural moms through expanded maternal health services, telehealth, and funding to hire more health professionals and care coordinators.
- **\$2.2 million through the first of its kind Delta Region Maternal Care Coordination (Delta MCC) Program** to expand and improve health care services before, during, and after pregnancy for mothers living in the Delta Region.
