



FY 2024: HRSA's Rural Health Grants

Republic of Marshall Islands Fact Sheet | November 2024

The Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) – through the Federal Office of Rural Health Policy (FORHP) – provided \$300,000 in funding to the Republic of Marshall Islands to increase health care access and strengthen health networks. FORHP also supports HRSA's goal to achieve equity for rural Americans by funding efforts to strengthen health care delivery systems, advance maternal health care, reduce the morbidity and mortality associated with substance use disorder, and improve the financial viability of rural hospitals.

By increasing access to quality services, these investments from FORHP have allowed communities in the Republic of Marshall Islands and across the country to improve health outcomes and address health disparities.
